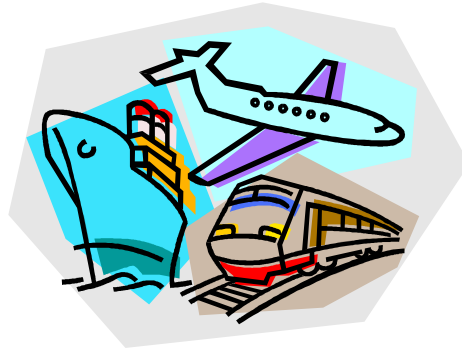


IT'S A NEW YEAR! APPLY FOR YOUR PASSPORTS NOW!



Effective June 1, 2009, all U.S. citizens age 16 and older are now required to present a passport book, passport card, or [WHTI-compliant document](#) when entering the United States by any method of travel (land, sea, or air). Children age 15 and under can still cross land and sea borders using their birth certificates.

The San Bernardino City Clerk's Office wants to help you get your passports for you and your family by visiting our next passport night. These events are open to the general public. Come and apply for your passports after-hours on:

February 24th, March 31st & April 28, 2010

From 4:30 - 6:30 p.m.
