City adds to its environmentally conscious fleet

The City of San Bernardino Fleet Division is continuing its efforts to help reduce the amount of air pollution within the South Coast Air Basin with the recent purchase of 12 liquid natural gas (LNG) refuse vehicles.

“Clean-fueled vehicles greatly reduce the emissions produced by older diesel powered vehicles they have replaced,” said Fleet Services Division Manager Don Johnson. “With 52 vehicles in our fleet, it shows a concerted effort on the part of the City to help protect the environment.”

The vehicles were partially funded through monies from a Mobile Source Air Pollution Review Committee (M.S.R.C.) grant, which provides funds to help pay the additional costs of these clean fuel models.

In addition to the new vehicles, The City’s new LNG/CNG fueling station is operational and open. The fueling station was funded through various state and federal grants and the CNG portion is open to the public.

The City of San Bernardino’s Public Services Fleet Division will continue to investigate means to reduce the air pollution in the South Coast Air Basin where our residents reside.
