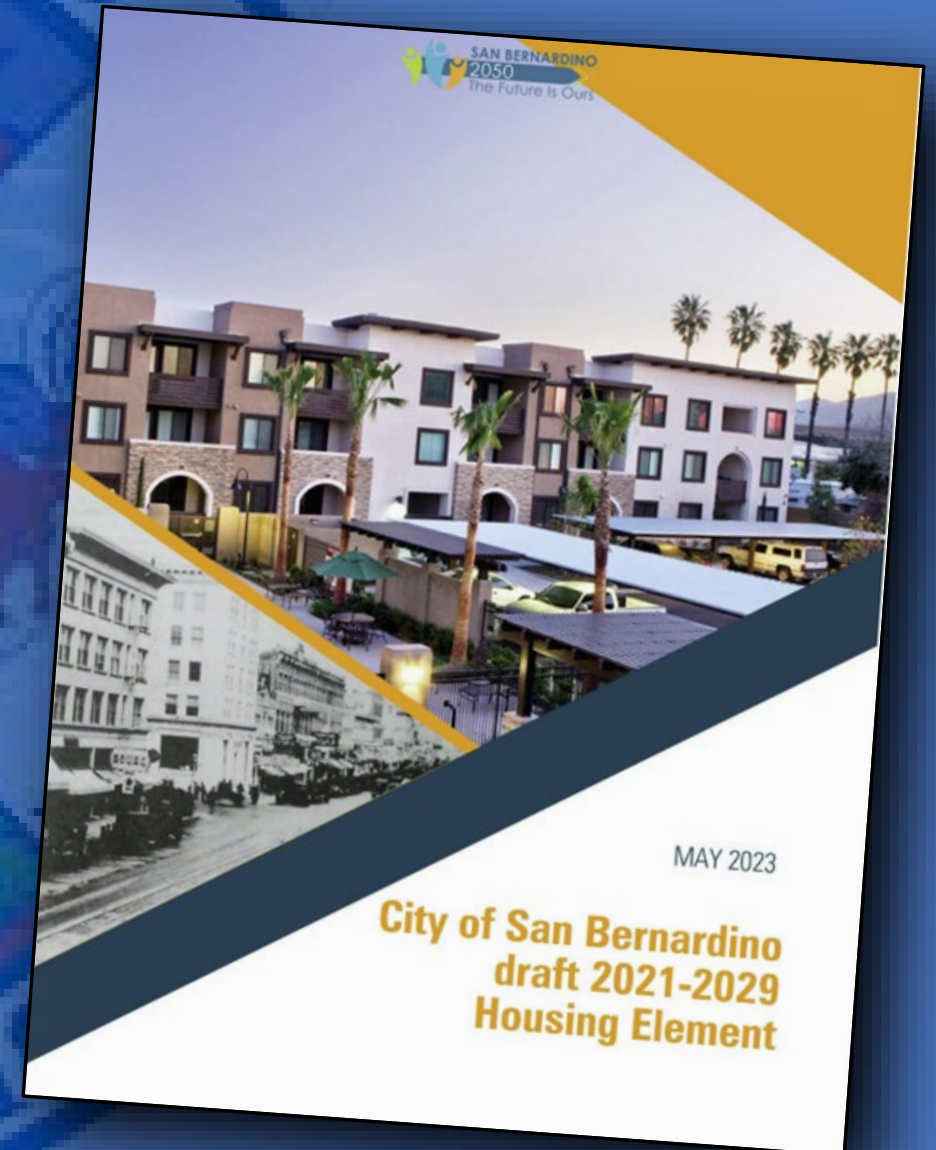

# Draft Housing Element Now Available

The City has released its draft 2021-2029 Housing Element for public review and comment at <https://futuresb2050.com/>

The Housing Element provides guidance for the development, improvements, rehabilitation, and provision of housing for San Bernardino residents. It incorporates the City's RHNA allocation of housing, including affordable housing.

The deadline to provide comment is June 12. It is tentatively scheduled to be reviewed by the Planning Commission in July.

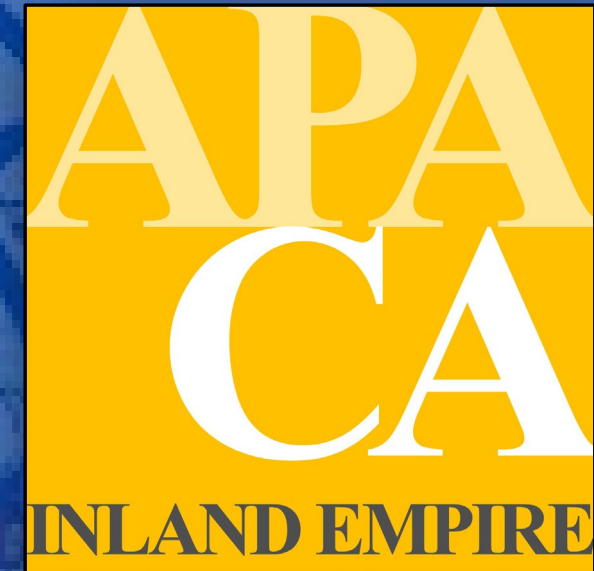


# City Wins American Planning Association Award

Last week, San Bernardino received a Transportation Planning Award from the Inland Chapter of the American Planning Association for the City's Active Transportation Plan.

Approved by the Council in July, 2022, the Active Transportation Plan seeks to expand alternative transportation infrastructure and programming using means such as walking, biking, public transit.
